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

- It is a Central Sector Scheme
- Launched on 6 nov 2024
- Nodal Department The Department of Higher Education
- Eligibility Criteria:- Students enrolled in institutions ranked within the top 100 by the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), and those in the 101-200 range from state government and all central government governed institutions.
- Supplementing Existing Schemes:- The scheme supplements the two components, Credit Guarantee Fund for Education Loans (CGFSEL) and Central Sector Interest Subsidy (CSIS), under the existing PM-Uchchatar Shiksha Protsahan

- Launched on Sept.7,2022.
- The duration of the scheme is from 2022-23 to 2026-27
- This is a centrally sponsored scheme for upgradation and development of more than 14500 Schools across the country by strengthening the selected existing schools from amongst schools managed by Central Government/ State/ UT Government/ local bodies.
- Under the PM SHRI, maximum 402 govt schools have been selected from Rajasthan in 1st stage.
- PM SHRI Schools will showcase all components of the National Education Policy 2020.

Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA)

- Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) is an integrated scheme for school education extending from pre-school to class XII to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education at all levels of school education.
- It subsumes the 3 Schemes of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) and Teacher Education (TE).
- The Scheme is being implemented as a Centrally

(PM-USP) scheme.

An outlay of ₹ 3,600 Crore has been made during
 2024-25 to 2030-31.

Sponsored Scheme.

The fund sharing pattern for the scheme between Centre and States is in the ratio of 90:10 for the North-Eastern States and the Himalayan States and 60:40 for all other States and Union Territories with Legislature.

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
